



**Goal:** Develop a research agenda on restorative justice to improve outcomes and address inequities in the context of the US criminal legal system.

### **What is a research agenda?**

A resource for informing funders, advocates, practitioners, researchers, and other stakeholders about priority topics for research and for coordinating efforts among these groups.

### **How is the RJRC developing a research agenda?**

Development is multifaceted with broad engagement from a variety of stakeholders. The agenda will be a living document that is adapted as new knowledge and shared learnings emerge. Efforts include:

- Literature review to understand and organize what is already known in this area.
- Focus group style roundtable discussions.
- Community survey.
- Collaborative working session.

### **Timeline**

- Sep 2022 – Project launch and literature review begins.
- Nov 2022 – Focus group roundtables begin.
- Jun 2023 – Collaborative working session.
- Dec 2023 – Research agenda version 1 published.
